Camouflage clothing	Participants cannot be traced easily when lost		
Hunting/ military boots	Heavy, bulky, uncomfortable, insufficient ankle support, cause blisters		
Jeans/ sleeveless tops	Uncomfortable when hiking, cause irritations		
BBQ grills	Dangerous, harmful to the environment		
One use utensil, cutlery, dishes, cups	Harmful to the environment		
Alcoholic drinks, cigarettes	Against Award regulations, illegal for minors, bad for health		
GPS devices	Discourage the spirit of adventure and critical thinking		
Clothing made of cotton	Hydrophilic, absorb moisture and can cause hypothermia
